Sher Shah Suri Tomb

This tomb is situated in the middle of a huge pond spread over an area of 22 acres, whose length (east to west) is 1130 feet and width (north to south) is 865 feet. To reach the tomb, one has to pass through the small domed tomb of Sher Shah's concierge located to the north of the pond. The turrets built on all three storeys with grandeur add to its grandeur and present the best specimen of Pathan architecture. For this reason, Kanindham has considered it even better than the Taj Mahal.
